The Telafina XII collection signals a stylistic shift in the brand to focus on urban, modern luxe with a pared-back, mostly monochromatic palette.

A chic and minimal color range of camel, zinc, graphite, platinum and onyx tones lets unexpected constructions, textural elements and luxurious materials take center stage, and will allow future collections to integrate seamlessly with each other.

Telafina XII balances references from the natural world with a sleek and contemporary design aesthetic. Patterns this season include lush flocked designs on a matte, natural ground cloth, appliqués of rich velvet on linen, jacquard motifs with a hint of metallic luster and a stunning allover fil-coupé texture.



VENETA

Pattern Veneta draws inspiration from two art forms: the signature leather intrecciato weave design of Bottega Veneta, the Italian luxury goods house founded in the Veneto region of northern Italy, and sgraffito, the centuries-old scratch technique used to create intricate designs on plaster, pottery and with paint. The result is a grid of delicate sgraffito-style lines created with flock on a natural, linen-blend base cloth.

PHILO

Philo is a richly mottled flock design referencing Venetian plaster and the textural effect produced by the method of fresco secco. The soft, plush hand of the flocking contrasts the dry, natural ground cloth.
