

EASY RIDER II

Please read the following important information regarding the patterns in Easy Rider II in order to best care for and maintain your upholstery:

- Items listed as stain resistant is never 100 % stain "proof". **Note:** Ink and Shoe polish will permanently stain regular PVC.
- Direct sunlight will deteriorate the fabric. Fabric is not made for outdoor use. In order to avoid any damage, the fabric should be kept away from direct exposure to the sun.
- Polyurethane is subject to **color migration** from other colors of this same fabric. To avoid color transfer the surface of this fabric should not come in contact with another color of this same fabric.
- It is the customer's responsibility to avoid applications where the face of the vinyl comes in contact with itself. Face to face fabric contact, along with environmental issues and/or pressure may result in peeling of the vinyl.
- **Color transfer** may also occur with fabrics such as denim, sensuede or faux suede in dark colors that are naturally subject to crocking. Crocking often occurs in these types of fabrics in dark saturated colors like black, blue, and red.
- Upholstery nails/tacks are recommended as glue may react negatively with the chemicals in the PU or PVC.
- Faux leather/vinyl has a tendency to wrinkle or pucker when upholstering long pieces, such as benches or sectionals. To help prevent this, tufting or seaming is recommended.
- Faux Leathers are not breathable except for pattern - Outlaw

General Cleaning Instructions (for all items **except** Writers Block & Bewitched, Tortoise, Bareback, Tumbleweed):

- Clean or Wipe with warm water and mild soap such as Tide or any other non-solvent upholstery shampoo. Rub gently in a circular motion. Remove all stains and spills immediately. Avoid over wetting. Do not dry in direct sunlight. Do not dry with a hair dryer.
- **Do not use chemical cleaning agents on items not labeled safe to do so.** Fabrics will deteriorate over time if cleaned with chemicals. Always test any cleaning agent in a hidden part of the furniture before using.

General Customer Responsibilities:

It is the customer's responsibility to:

- Ensure a large enough seam allowance is used to prevent seam slippage.
- Decide the **appropriate application** for each fabric.
 - **Please note:** Maxwell Fabrics is committed to carrying fabrics from suppliers that meet or exceed all industry testing and standards. However, no tests are conducted with consideration to pet use as this is not considered normal use for residential fabric. Therefore, Maxwell Fabrics cannot guarantee/warrantee any fabric where pets are present under any

circumstances. It is the customer's responsibility to choose fabric appropriately with consideration of pets in the home/environment.

- **Writer's Block fabrics are suitable for healthcare, hospitality, contract, education and residential applications.**
- Writer's Block ink resistant technology offers a unique repel and release stain inhibiting system. This dual action topcoat prevents ink and other stains from setting into the material and allows for easy cleaning, even after longer periods of time. With the ability to withstand high dilutions of bleach or isopropyl alcohol any potential residue that may exist can be cleaned off easily.

- **Care and Cleaning Guide**
 - Prompt cleaning is always recommended. Cleaning steps are listed by type of stain.
- **Regular Cleaning and Maintenance**
 - (Dirt, Grime)
 - Clean the soiled area with mild soap and water, then rinse with fresh water and wipe dry with a clean cloth.
- **Food Stains/Oil**
 - (Mustard, Ketchup, Chocolate, Coffee/Tea, Salad Dressing)
 - Wipe the affected area with a soft cloth with appropriate pressure. If some stain persists, clean with mild soap and water. Rinse with fresh water and wipe dry.
- **Healthcare/Disinfection**
 - (Blood, Urine, Betadine)
 - Wipe the affected area with a soft cloth with appropriate pressure. If some stain persists,

spray it with a 70% dilution of isopropyl alcohol and water and wipe. Rinse with fresh water and wipe dry.

- **Ink Marks/Graffiti**
- (Ballpoint Pen/Permanent Marker)
- Rub the affected area with a dry soft cloth with firm pressure. If some stain is still present spray it with a 70% dilution of isopropyl alcohol and water and wipe. Rinse with fresh water and wipe dry.

- **Denim Dye Transfer**
- (Blue Jeans)
- This material is designed to withstand the transfer of most types of Indigo Dye. In the case that faint dye transfer is visible, this can typically be removed with a 70% dilution of isopropyl alcohol and water.

- ****Note:** The information in this cleaning guide refers to performance in specific tests conducted under laboratory conditions. This information is not a guarantee that every stain will be removed completely. Some residual ghosting may be present after all cleaning steps are followed.

Care & Cleaning Guide: Bewitched, Tortoise, Bareback, Tumbleweed

Prompt cleaning is always recommended. Recommended cleaning steps are listed by type of stain. For best results follow cleaning steps in order.

Recommended Care and Cleaning Steps

Step 1: Mild soap and water, then rinse with fresh water and wipe dry with a clean lint free cloth.

Step 2: Wipe affected area with a soft cloth or soft bristle brush using a non-abrasive cleaner, for example Formula 409 or Fantastik. Rinse with fresh water and wipe dry.

Step 3: 10% solution of household bleach and water. Rinse with fresh water and wipe dry
