Performance Wovens is back with two new color books focusing on versatile small-scale designs and textures with coordinating solids, all stocked with Nanotex aSure or Crypton Home permanent soil and stain repellent technology designed to last the life of the fabric.

Nanotex aSure is the latest addition to our performance story this season and provides a fluid barrier for spill protection along with exceptional cleanability.

Performance Wovens brings the hand and style of residential fabrics to the realm of commercial upholstery with its cleanability and performance story. This series is a crossover star, ideal for settings ranging from a laidback family room to the chic hotel bar.

Standout patterns this season include Leo, a highly useable two-tone leopard rosette; Streamline, a modern, angular geometric motif; Bird's Eye, a perfectly-scaled graphic ogee dot; and Holt, a cuddly and plush solid.

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UPHOLSTERY



Palm Beach serves up a palette inspired by the Art Deco historic district of Miami. Canary yellow mingles with flamingo and cameo pinks. Blues range from delphinium and cobalt to peacock. Greens are found in adaptable, useable tints such as jadeite, aloe and pistachio.

Stoneware is a range of neutrals influenced by the rustic Japanese style of pottery known as raku. Deep graphite and onyx shades, reminiscent of smoke-darkened unglazed clay, are shown alongside soft bisque, talc and optic white. The addition of brass and zinc metallics provide subtle glamour.

All patterns in Performance Wovens pass the performance guidelines established by the Association for Contract Textiles (ACT) for woven upholstery fabrics in high traffic/public spaces.
